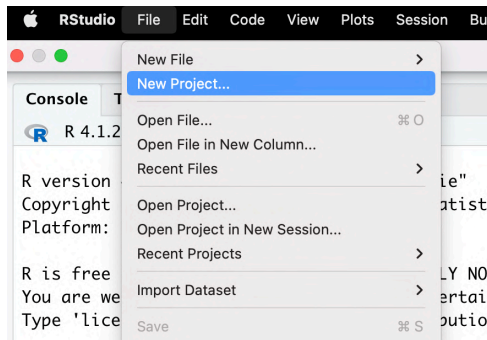


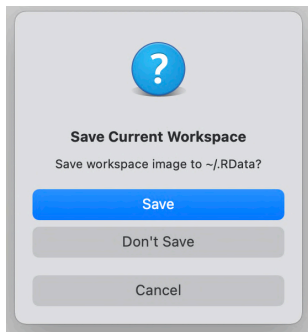

Create a project versioned with git

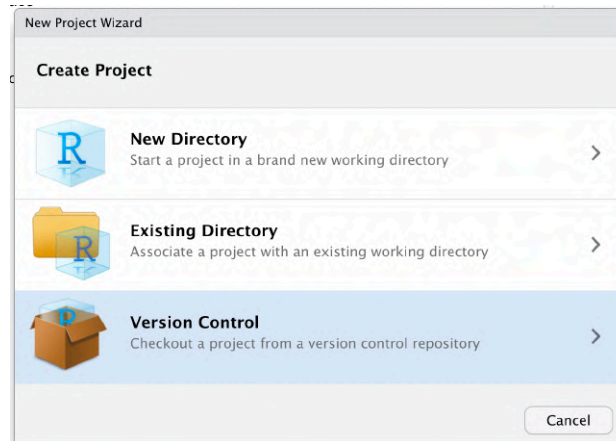
1 Click on RStudio > New Project



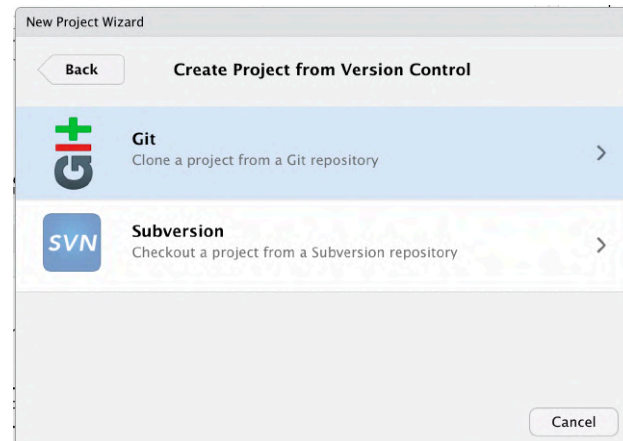
2 Save or not your Workspace



3 Select 'Version Control'



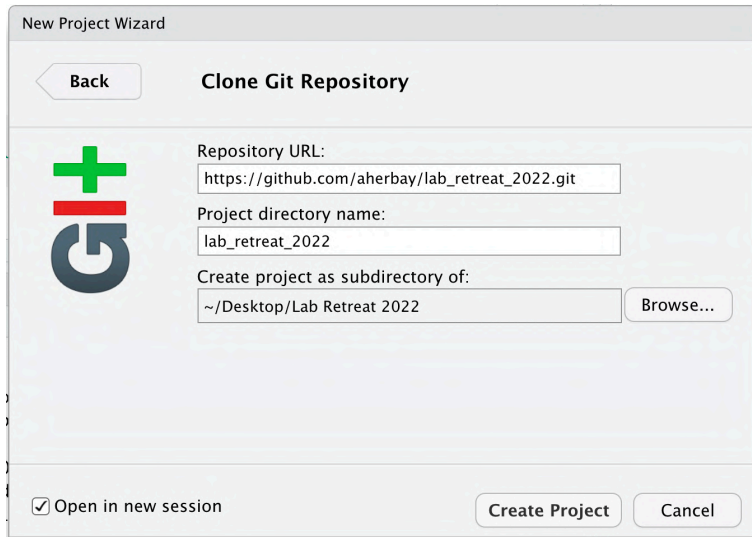
4 Select 'Git'

Create a project versioned with git

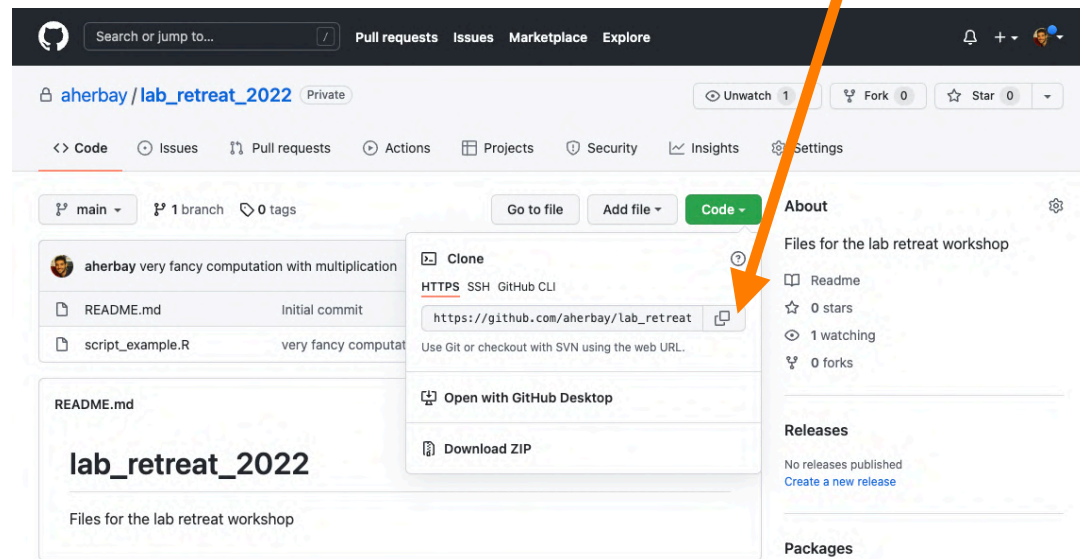
5 Copy the URL of your GitHub repository (see on the right side of this slide) and indicate the project name and its location



6 Click on 'Create Project'

TO GET THE HTTPS URL OF YOUR GITHUB REPO:

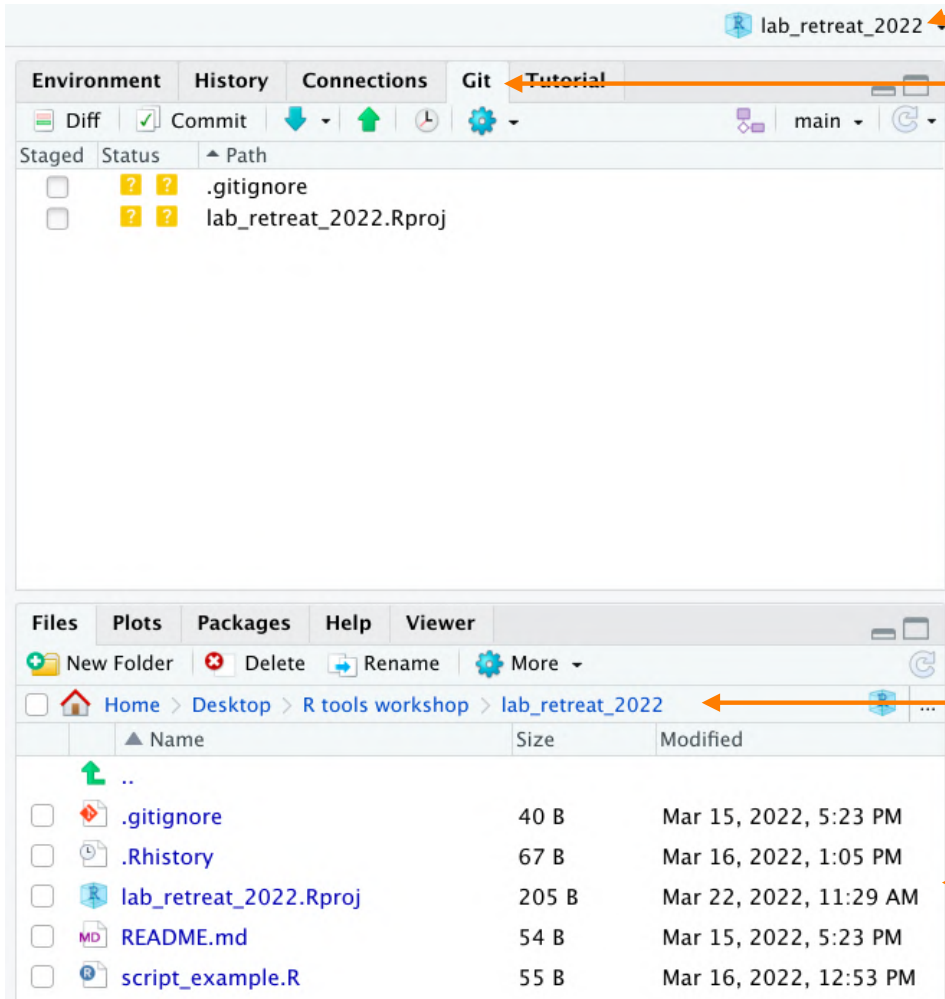
1. Go on your GitHub account and in the specific repo
2. Click on the green button 'Code'
3. Click on 'HTTPS' and on the button  next to the URL to copy it
